Conflict minerals and the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.

EU 2017/821 laying down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas;

Numatic International Ltd declares that it is aware of the existence of this US regulation and acknowledges that there is a European Directive placing obligation to importers of 3TG if above the limits set out in Annex 1 of the directive

There are many actors in the current supply chain that are not fully conversant with this act and that makes verification challenging.

Nevertheless, the organization has attempted to identify potential risks of conflict minerals in the supply chain and ensure that no such minerals find their way into Numatic products.

It is our policy that we will not knowingly use components that are manufactured from materials from conflict areas.

Our declaration is that to the best knowledge available, our products exclude the use of conflict minerals as defined by the Dodd – Frank act and we are not in scope of EU 2017/821
